



## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

As part of its food safety policy, the company is committed to respecting the environment in the manufacturing of its products. Therefore, High Protein de México, S.A. de C.V. is committed to complying with all applicable environmental regulations.

For this reason, Management is committed to ensuring compliance. The Plant General Manager is responsible for this policy, its enforcement, monitoring, measurement, and any corrective actions that may arise from changes in laws or internal processes.

The company must obtain and maintain an operating permit or license from the Ecology Department of the Municipality of El Salto. This permit ensures the company's compliance with local legislation. Furthermore, the company is committed to obtaining the Single Environmental License, a coordinated process among authorities that consolidates the evaluation, issuance, and monitoring of various obligations related to the prevention and control of emissions and transfers to the environment into a single process. This includes monitoring air pollution, waste generation and integrated management, recording wastewater discharges into the sewer system, water consumption, electricity consumption, and the establishment of and participation in contingency plans, through the analysis of submitted documentation.

The foregoing is intended to formulate preventive and corrective measures that establish the necessary conditions for legal operation and functioning. Furthermore, this ensures compliance with current environmental legislation and falls within the scope of authority of the Ministry of Environment and Natural Resources (SEMARNAT), the Ministry of Environment for Territorial Development (SEMADET in Jalisco), and the municipalities.

Another of the company's most significant commitments will always be the reduction and/or mitigation of the environmental impacts it tends to generate. Therefore, the General Management is committed to establishing feasible goals and controls for environmental protection, legal compliance, and meeting the company's needs.

The commitment encompasses everything from controlling emissions and transfers that could pollute the air, water, soil, and subsoil, to the proper handling of materials and waste, as well as the sustainable use of renewable and non-renewable natural resources.

For each of the environmental aspects or matters established in this policy, High Protein de México establishes its operational controls within each area to guarantee environmental protection.

However, in the event that an operational control fails due to any action or omission, contingency plans are implemented, outlining the necessary actions to prevent further environmental damage.
